Objective: This evidence-based project focused on improving nursing student skill competency in four specific skills which were identified by local hospitals as needing improvement. This was accomplished by utilizing simulation education and objective structured clinical examination testing. Methods: The project site was a small private college in upstate New York. Participants were senior nursing students graduating from the Associate Degree in Applied Science in Nursing program. Twenty-nine participants completed the project.
